## Sick Child Policy

If a child is exhibiting any of the following symptoms, they may not stay at school. They will be allowed to return once they are symptom free for 24 hours and will be required to provide a doctor's note OR proof that they have tested negative for COVID 19.

- Temperature of 100 or higher
- Nausea, Vomiting or Diarrhea
- Chills
- Cough
- Muscle or Body aches
- Headaches
- Loss of smell or taste
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Sore throat
- Fatigue
- Two or more cold symptoms

If a child is exhibiting any of the following symptoms, they may not stay at school. They will be allowed to return once they are symptom free for 24 hours and will be required to provide a doctor's note.

- Undiagnosed rash on the body
- Cloudy discharge from the eye(s)
- Any communicable disease

Please note:

- If a child experiences any symptoms of illness while in our care, they will be isolated and parents will be contacted to make arrangements to pick the child up as soon as possible. Please remember isolation is a temporary situation and the child must be picked up as soon as possible.
- When children are at school, they should be able to participate fully in the program, including going outdoors.
- In order to give children prescription medications, we must have all of the medicine forms completed. Please check the medicine list and medicine pass each day. Be sure to bring the medication (dated for the current illness) in its original container with the child's name and dosage information on it. All information on the prescription and the school forms must be consistent in order for the child's medication to be administered.

*Failure to comply with the Sick Child Policy may result in termination from the program.*
