Sick Child Policy

We are committed to maintaining the good health of the children as much as possible. We ask that you cooperate in this effort.

When children have any of the following conditions they may not stay at school:

- Temperature of 101 or higher
- Vomiting
- Diarrhea – 2 or 3 loose stools in a short time
- Two or more cold symptoms
- Undiagnosed rash on the body ***
- Cloudy discharge from the eye(s) ***
- Any communicable disease ***

*****A doctor's note must be presented upon return to the office when a child is sent home with these symptoms.**

We require that children not return to the center until symptoms have been gone for 24 hours.

Children who are sick will be isolated. Remember isolation is a temporary situation, and the child must be picked up immediately.

In order to give children prescription medications, we must have all of the medicine forms completed. Please check the medicine list and medicine pass each day. Be sure to bring the medication (dated for the current illness) in its original container with the child's name and dosage information on it.

In order to administer non-prescription medications (over the counter), we must have a current note from the child's doctor. The note from the doctor must contain: child's name, date, name of the medicine, dosage, times to be given and doctor's contact information.

When children are at school they should participate fully in the program, including going outdoors.

Failure to comply with the Sick Policy will result in termination from the program.
